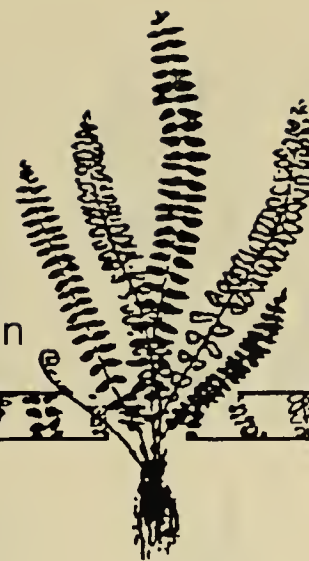

This "Directory..." is respectfully and fondly dedicated to the memory of Drs. Warren H. (Herb) Wagner (1920-2000) and Irving Knobloch (1907-1999), two of the finest fern scientists of our time and mentors to so many others.

In 1994 **THE HARDY FERN FOUNDATION** sponsored a state-by-state guide to gardens (public and private) and nurseries (large and small) in the United States that had interesting collections of ferns and allied plants. That first "Directory..." had 116 entries in 29 states plus the District of Columbia.

In this year 2000 revision there are 206 entries in 33 states, D.C., and Canada indicating that fern growing is still an important – even an expanding – part of the botanical and horticultural arenas. The editors have made every effort to have as complete a "Directory..." as possible and would appreciate being notified of additions and corrections.

All the information in this updated "Directory..." has been provided by the owners, managers or directors of the places listed. Anyone planning to visit a listed garden or nursery should pay courteous attention to the days and hours of operation and whether an appointment is needed.

The computer data entry for this revision was custom designed by the junior editor Sara J. Gottlieb to whom loving gratitude is given by her mother, the senior editor.

A "Guide to Fern Gardens, Collections and Nurseries" also exists for British ferns. It was published in May, 1991 by the British Pteridological Society, c/o Botany Department, Natural History Museum, Cromwell Road, London SW7 5BD, England.

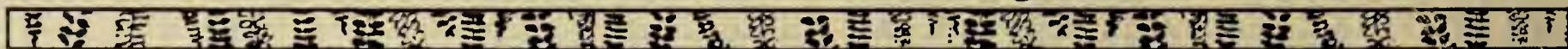
